

Guideline for speakers

(5 minutes video presentations)

ICMCS'20 will be hosted via a video conferencing application which allows joining the event via internet (computer and smartphones).

Researchers (PhD holders and PhD students) are encouraged to prepare 5-minutes video of their latest or ongoing researches to be presented in the framework of ICMCS'20. It is an occasion for those researchers to consolidate their ideas to an audience of experts.

We ask researchers to be a good presenter as much as they can. The official presentation language is English. They should be a good ambassador for their university. Prepare their lecture and practice presenting it. They are invited to respect the following recommendations:

- Prepare presentation within time constraints (5 min).
- Add the ICMCS conference logo on the top of slides.

- Use visuals (figures, images, videos) much more than texts.
- Look for simplicity and consistency.
- Make sure that presentation includes: Summary, problematic, illustration and figures-based explanation, eventual experimentation and results, and conclusion.
- Take care of sound quality and boost volume.
- Rehearse presentation.
- Record and upload presentation in the personal drive and make sure that it is well shared. Video Proposals Deadline: **September 24, 2020.**
